Tournament Tee Times:

First round pairings will be published no later than December 26 on the tournament website and will be sent via email. Final round practice rounds will be published via email and the tournament website shortly after the conclusion of the first round.

-First round tee times are tentatively scheduled to begin at 9:00am starting on #1 and #10.

-Final round tee times are tentatively scheduled to begin at 8:00am starting on #1 and #10.

Weather Delays:

All weather delay announcements will be communicated as soon as possible via email and on posted to the tournament website. Delay information can also be found on the scrolling message board.

Practice Rounds:

Practice rounds are available to be played upon entry receipt and confirmation by contacting the golf shop at 205-956-1599. Tee times can be scheduled up to 7 days in advance. Practice rounds are unavailable on Mondays, December 24, and December 25. The green fee for a registered tournament player and a parent/guardian to play is \$30 each which includes golf cart (whether you walk or ride, play nine or eighteen holes). A player must have a valid driver's license to drive a golf cart without a parent/guardian.

Spectator Carts during Tournament Round

Spectators may rent a golf cart from the golf shop for \$20 on a first-come-first-served basis. Spectator carts must remain on the golf cart paths at all times. *Players and/or golf bags may NOT ride in a golf cart at any time during a round.* Pine Tree Country Club and/or the tournament committee reserve the right to revoke a spectator cart at any time for any reason.

Practice Facility

The driving range will open 1 hour before the first tee time. Please note the driving range will close for the day after the last pairing begins their rounds on Monday, December 30. The putting and chipping greens will remain open until dusk.

Dress Code

Pine Tree Country Club permits all current trends and traditional forms of golf attire. For males, this includes, but is not limited to, Bermuda length and style shorts or golf slacks, and golf shirts with a collar. For females, this includes, but is not limited to, Bermuda length and style shorts, golf slacks, golf skirts, and skorts. Long-sleeve turtlenecks, long sleeve mock-neck shirts, and appropriate rain-gear are also permitted if weather-appropriate. T-shirts, gym shorts, jeans, tank tops, and mid-riffs are all prohibited.

Acceptable footwear include tennis shoes, smooth bottomed shoes and golf shoes with softspikes or 'soft' soles; cleats for other sports (baseball, soccer, track, etc.) and metal golf spikes are prohibited.

Withdrawal Policy

A player or players may withdraw from the event prior to the official close of entries for a 100% refund. A player or players may withdraw from the event prior to the official publishing of first round tee times for a 100% refund less \$20. Once the tee times have been officially been published for the first round, no refund will be given. 100% refunds will be given if the entire event is cancelled.

Weather-related Provision

If weather and/or darkness forces a round to be cancelled or shortened, any like holes completed by an entire age group (including the 'overall' age groups) will be deemed to be a complete round.

Spectator Code of Conduct

Spectators must remain "at a distance" and do nothing that may be construed as giving advice, obstruct play of any player, obstruct the operation of the tournament, or obstruct the tournament staff. Spectators must remain to the sides of players, out of fairways and away playing corridors. Please note, contacting the golf shop or a rules official via cell phone for purposes of a getting an official ruling is permitted. Spectators may also assist in locating potentially lost golf balls. Spectators in violation may cause unnecessary penalties for players. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to dismiss any spectators at any time.

Other Information

1. The 2019-2020 USGA Rules of Golf will be in effect
2. *All players must walk at all times during the round, including between holes.*

3. Distance measuring devices will be allowed provided they do not measure anything besides distance (wind, slope, temperature, etc).
4. No caddies; all players must walk and transport their own bags. Push carts are permitted.
5. **Pine Tree Country Club does not accept CASH as a form of payment.**
