

The 11th Dave Ragan Cup Matches



October 2 - 4, 2020

The Dave Ragan Cup Matches is a Ryder Cup style tournament for players who earn their way into the event by playing in tournaments throughout the year. Qualifiers are placed on either the Red Team or the Blue Team and compete over 54-holes with day one featuring foursome matches, day two four-ball matches, and day three individual matches. Players / Teams earn points for each match won or halved and a team needs 16½ points to win The Dave Ragan Cup. The tournament bears the name of Dave Ragan, honoring his service to Pine Tree as Director of Golf and Teaching Professional and his 5 PGA Tour wins and appearance in the 1963 Ryder Cup.

Qualifying

Players are invited based on their standing on the Official Points List

Points are awarded three ways:

Participation Points are awarded to each player who starts a tournament. 100 points for a major and 50 points for others.

Competition Points are earned based on the player's finishing position. One point for each dollar won in golf shop credit.

Bonus Points are awarded to players based on the number of tournaments played.

Six Tournaments - 750

Seven Tournaments - 1500
